ST JOHN'S PARISH HALL

Work is in progress replacing the pine hall floor (which had served the hall well for nearly 110 years) with a new Junkers Maple floor which will hopefully serve the hall and our community just as well for the next 100 years. Next week the badminton court will be marked out and final varnish applied and the hall will be ready for Kingston Kindergarten Nursery and the other users on 3 September.

There will be a planned redecoration of the hall in the coming year in preparation for the 110th anniversary of its opening in 1903. Most of this work will be carried out by volunteers so get yourselves ready to help. Details will be given in future Springboards.

ST JOHN'S CHURCH

As outlined in previous Springboards and in the Church presentations, about £500,000 has to be raised to carry out Phase One of the Church project to replace electrics, heating etc and to provide disabled access. The detailed plans for this work will cost £45,000 (for which £26,000 has been raised), and then planning applications and applications for grants can be made. 
